

# 2023/WEB08 PRACTICAL ROOT CAUSE ANALYSIS

# **OVERVIEW**

In our current audit environment, we certainly can do better at understanding our businesses and addressing root causes for audit findings. If the audit team doesn't perform effective root cause analysis, then addressing symptoms or effects instead of real root causes does not solve the problem.

At the exit meetings, the auditors highlight their findings and perhaps symptoms rather than real root causes. It is not uncommon for auditors to assume what the root cause is or use past reported root causes. Auditors do find that identifying and validating root causes takes too much time and there are no systematic methodology or tools for RCA in their workspace.

Team leads and audit managers are faced with poorly addressed root causes and hence the never ending "recurring audit findings" that reflects poorly on the audit function in terms of adding value and improving business operations. In many cases, audit recommendations are not aligned with the "root causes" and hence the recurring issues.

To resolve this gap in root cause analysis, auditors need to establish methodology, tools and practices that work.
