PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This program is part of the Applied Data Analytics in Risk, Control and Audit TM series created and delivered by MBS Academy. The program covers advanced concepts of Data Analytics, such as Business Intelligence, Continuous Assurance and Continuous Monitoring, that Audit and Risk professionals and teams can apply in their everyday work.
