Process for Recognition

- Contact your local IIA Chapter or Affiliate for assistance with the Recognition Form.
- Complete and submit The IIA Request for Recognition Form, which can be requested via academic@theiia.org.
- Acceptance Notification: Universities will receive communication within 60 days regarding their application status.
- Annual Validation: Universities must annually confirm their compliance with Awareness criteria by completing a report provided by The IIA Academic Relations team.
