PROCUREMENT FRAUD: 3RD PARTY DUE DILIGENCE, INTERNAL CONTROLS AND REPORTING MECHANISM

## **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

According to the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) complaints bureau, most bribery and corruption complaints from 2013 to 2018 had been allegations involving the procurement sector. It is a high-risk sector which requires heightened control measures and monitoring mechanism to ensure staff/person associated from either end do not condone to such fraudulent conduct. To date, we still observe that organizations are struggling to manage third-party risk and acquiring the required information to detect and investigate such incidences.

The program sheds light on common schemes perpetrated throughout the procurement lifecycle. It takes participants through the entire procurement process and initiates the discussion on prevention, detection and response mechanisms that can be implemented at an organizational level.
