



CORPORATE LIABILITY UNDER MACC ACT SECTION 17A: DEVELOPING AND AUDITING YOUR ANTI-BRIBERY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM



OVERVIEW

The MACC (Amendment) Act 2018 Section 17A came into effect on 1st June 2020, introducing corporate liability for corruption offences for the first time in Malaysia. The Amendment means that company directors and senior management will now be held personally liable for acts of corruption committed by the company, either by their own personnel or by parties acting on behalf the organisation. Penalties include fines and prison sentences of up to 20 years for those in charge of the business. However, companies which have been proactive in preventing corruption occurring can present the defence of having “adequate procedures” in place, to prove the necessary measures were taken to prevent the incident occurring and therefore those in charge should not be held liable.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The programme will explain the MACC Amendment, along with related international legislation, and guide participants how to establish the necessary adequate procedures using the official Malaysian Government guide published by the Prime Ministers Department. Delegates will be equipped with an in-depth understanding of the new legislation, what the adequate procedures should require in practice, and direction on how to set up and audit the main procedures with reference to ISO 37001.
