A. Criteria for Nomination.

- i. Nominee MUST be a Professional / Fellow member of IIAM as of 22nd May 2026;

Preferably ;

- i. served in sub-committee of IIAM for minimum 1 year.
- ii. a CIA/CRMA/CCSA/CGAP/CFSA/QIAL or equivalent professional qualification.
- iii. An existing/ former Chief Audit Executive / Head of Internal Audit or holding / has held senior management position in private or public sector.
- iv. Desired competencies:
 - Strategic thinking and local perspective;
 - Leadership capabilities;
 - Business acumen (e.g. financial expertise, risk management, advocacy, governance, information technology);
 - Fiduciary responsibility (e.g., put The IIAM first); and
 - Excellent written and verbal communication skills.

B. General Requirements.

- i. In order to serve, you **must**:
 - Be able to commit time (see details below)
 - Agree to comply with the IIAM's Anti-bribery and Corruption Framework for the following:
 - Due diligence process which includes the authorisation of credit/trade check, DCHEQS checks on me and where applicable, with CTOS to be conducted by The IIAM.

C. Time Commitment.
